Religion (Nennig)

Language Arts (LeWarne)

7th graders are off to a great start! They have learning about the structure and function of animal and plant cells and are just beginning to learn about cell processes. We did an experiment with a raw egg as a model of a cell to observe diffusion, which the kids enjoyed. Please continue to work with your child on organizational skills and use of their planners.

Math (Streff)

- Students have been hard at work on Chapter 1, Decimals and Integers. This is a chapter filled with lots of different concepts and 7th graders are doing great keeping up with them all.
- Next week will be the Chapter 1 test. Students can start reviewing estimation, decimals, metric conversions, integers, and vocabulary. Prepare and you will succeed!
