Book

Author (Last name, First name). Title of Book. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication.

(Magazine or newspaper article)

Author. "Title of Article." Title of Magazine/Newspaper. Date of Publication: Page Number(s).

Electronic Resources

(A website)(if there is no author, just start with "Name of Page")

Author(s). Name of Page. Date of Posting/Revision. Name of Institution/ Organization affiliated with the site. Date of Access <electronic address>.

(Television or radio program)

"Episode Title." Title of TV Show. Network. Television Station, State. Date Broadcast.

Additional Notes and Tips for Citations

- *Always list all authors' names (Last name, First name)
- *When plugging in full dates of publication or date of access use this form:
Day Month Year-(24 January 2007)
- *Follow correct punctuation for each type of citation (periods)
- *Capitalize the first letter of each section of a citation
- *Underline all titles of books, magazines, and newspapers
- *Abbreviate state names- Iowa: IA
- *Indent the second line of each citation
- *Identify as much of the required information as possible
- *Never assume information for a citation. BE ACCURATE!
