

Finding Citation Information

Author's Name

There is not always an author, if there is one their name can usually be found:

- At the beginning of the article
- At the bottom of the page with the copyright information (the web page designer is usually not the author)
- Somewhere on the Home Page
- Under contact information

Organization Title

If the page was not created by an author, it will be created by an organization. (Sometimes you can find both) To find the organization that owns the page you can usually find it:

- At the top of the page
- At the bottom of the page with the copyright information (the web page designer is usually not the organization)
- Somewhere on the Home Page
- Under contact information

Web page or article title

The article title is usually in smaller print:

- At the top of the page
- In the middle of the page above where you found your information

Web Site Title

This may be the same as the organization title and is usually always found:

- At the top of the page
- Somewhere on the Home Page

Web URL (aka Web Address)

Copy and paste from the address bar

Publish Date

This can usually be found:

- Towards the top of the page
- By the article title
- At the bottom of the page (can use copyright date)

Never cite Google or other Search Engines as a bibliographic source!
